Seasonal and Indoor Plant Tips

Culture

- This is a good time to take and root, stem and leaf cuttings from vigorously growing house plants.
- It is also a good time to re-pot and divide houseplants. Be sure to wash out any fertilizer salt residues from the containers. Use lightweight, well-drained soil less potting mixes containing peat moss, and perlite. These ready-made mixes contain fertilizers that will meet a houseplant's nutritional requirements for 2-3 months.
